

NOTICE OF PLANNING ASSESSMENT COMMISSION MEETING

Collector Wind Farm Project MOD 1

The Department of Planning and Environment (DP&E) has completed its assessment of the above proposal. The application has been referred to the Planning Assessment Commission (the Commission) for determination, under the terms of the Minister's delegation.

The Commission to determine the application comprises Ms Abigail Goldberg (chair), Ms Annabelle Pegrum AM and Mr Roger Fisher.

Due to the level of public interest in the proposal, the Commission will be meeting to hear public views on the Assessment Report and recommendation, prior to determining the proposal. This is a final opportunity for interested parties to comment on the DP&E's assessment and recommended conditions of approval, before a decision is made.

The Commission meeting is scheduled to commence at 9:00am on Wednesday, 29 June 2016 at the Collector Memorial Hall, Bourke Street Collector NSW 2581. The meeting is open to the public to observe the proceedings. We were originally informed that the Collector venue was not available for the Commission meeting and proceeded to secure a different venue in Gunning. The Collector venue later advised us that it had rearranged its bookings and was able to accommodate the Commission meeting. Given the location of the site, we have changed the venue so that the Commission meeting can be held in Collector.
