I am dropping you an email as I will not be able to attend the commission meeting on 17/11/16 - but in no way should that be taken as an indication that my vehement objections to the redevelopment does not still stand. I am not opposed to the development in principle, but am opposed to the manifestly inadequate provision for car parking. To suggest that the number of car parking spots proposed is sufficient, is naive. There is enormous pressure on parking in the streets around technology park as it is - with the massive proposed increase in staff numbers at technology park with this proposed development - that pressure will be unbearable.

To be frank, the pressure on the surrounding roads if sufficient parking was provided would be awful, but this development moves what should be a technology park problem onto the shoulders of the surrounding residents. For technology park to wash its hands of the issue saying that they have a green parking plan and that everyone is going to cycle to work or catch the train is manifestly ignorant.

Provide sufficient parking, shuttle buses from central - look for alternatives! Don't suggest that people, currently working in the western suburbs, are going magically to cycle to work!

Don't make Technology Parks problem the problem of the surrounding residents!
