Rye Park Wind Farm Proposal - Reference D455/17 Rye Park Wind Farm

To the Planning Assessment Commission

I can't make the meeting in Boorowa on the 30th March due to work commitments. The concerns I have if the Wind Farm goes ahead is that the area zoned for compensation is no more than 1.2km from the wind turbines. This should be extended to at least 5km, which won't include many properties because a lot of property sizes in the vicinity are acres in the hundreds if not thousands, apart from the house blocks in the Rye Park Village and the smaller hobby farm's in the area. My property is 3.2km from a proposed turbine, but no compensation has been offered. Also, the money that they say the Community will be allocated, will it be given to the Rye Park community or be divided by Hilltops Council now the amalgamation has taken place?

The amount of proposed Wind Farms for the whole area is extensive. The amount of traffic that will go through Boorowa and Yass, via Cooks Hill road to access Flakney Creek Road will be relentless. I am worried about my personal safety as I ride a motorcycle to Canberra and return daily. I have had close calls with trucks travelling on Cooks Hill road already due to the road not being wide enough to allow two Vehicles to pass safely on the corners of most of the dirt road that is part of the Upper Lachlan Shire Councils zoning.

Hilltops Council had one of the devices that records the flow of traffic just over the creek crossing on the Rye Park side of Rosewood Stud on Dalton Road up until recently. What was the purpose of collecting that data? If the project goes ahead will the conditions of the roads be monitored, repaired or even upgraded? Please put my concerns forward I my absence at the meeting, as my personal safety is paramount to any decision.
