> I am one of the owners and occupiers of [REDACTED]. First of all I would like to say thank you for the decision in the current plans to remove the turbines that are directly behind my property. I feel like this is a huge step forward on the plans however I still have concerns for the entire project.

> One of my main concerns is still the increase of heavy traffic on the roads in the area, especially the gravel roads.
