I wish to recommend the IPC refusal of the proposed development of the Long Bow Point Golf Course.

I am a full time resident of Culburra Beach and would like to raise my concerns.

Living at East Crescent Culburra Beach I am privy to witness the vast number of birdlife that share Lake Wollumboola. I am fortunate enough to see for myself how vibrant and alive the lake is, hosting Black Swans, Pelicans, Teals, Seagulls, Herons and a variety of visiting migratory birds.

Summer brings recreational visitors to Lake Wollumboola, the clear water provides a harvest of prawns and fish, and the enjoyment of lake activities, kite surfing, canoeing and swimming just to name a few.

By allowing inappropriate development, we risk losing a special gift. Through extensive long term studies, all done with the assistance of experts, it has been identified that the lake catchment will be adversely affected by urban development and especially a golf course development given the amount of nutrient entering the lake via surface and ground water.
