## Updates after project commencement:

Professor Alice Clark was appointed to the Commission panel for the project on 16 November 2018. On 10 December 2018 Professor Clark was informed by her spouse that he holds a number of options in Glencore PLC (the applicant). Professor Clark immediately informed the Commission and considered the conflict of interest policy. The Commission also considered its conflict of interest policy. To avoid any potential or perceived conflict Professor Clark withdrew from the Commission panel on 10 December 2018.

Geoffrey Sharrock was appointed to the Commission panel for the project on 10 December 2018. On 12 December 2018 Mr Sharrock realised that he may have a perceived conflict as he was previously the Managing Director of Wambo Mining Corporation. Mr Sharrock resigned from that position in May 1999. Mr Sharrock immediately contacted the Commission and to avoid any potential or perceived conflict Mr Sharrock withdrew his nomination to the Commission panel. The Chair of the Commission appointed Robyn Kruk to the Commission panel in Mr Sharrock's place.
