


"Excluding the end use of coal"?

- Excluding the impacts of Australian coal burnt off shore is now more ridiculous







Coal is a bad investment

- > 46 countries, states, provinces & cities have joined a global alliance to phase out coal from power generation by 2030 & to cease further investment in coal power




