Objection to the Dartbrook Coal Mine Modification 7 (DA 231-7-2000 Mod 7)

This letter is to object to the application to reopen the Dartbrook coal mine. I object on the grounds that:

- The rejection in the Land and Environment Court of the Rocky Hill coal mine near Gloucester has highlighted that this is not the time in our history to be developing or reactivating coal mines.
