We are already saddened to see the destruction of the natural habitats next to Garrads Reserve, and clear-cutting of bushland containing many very old trees etc.

The proposal to add even more houses to this large subdivision seems totally unnecessary. The needs of the existing community should outweigh the putative benefits of development. Already there is a large new subdivision at Narrawallee, providing more traffic to formerly quiet roads, and no more facilities such as hospitals, shops, schools in the area.
