I am strongly opposed to the amended DA in Narrawallee for 6 extra house blocks at the southern end of the subdivision in Carinya St. This will destroy a lovely stand of tall trees, which provide shade for the council reserve strip along Seaspray St. The trees provide much needed habitat for native birds and wildlife, given the significant clear felling of forest adjacent to Garrads Reserve already undertaken in the project zone so far.
