





Conclusion

Koala Koalition EcoNetwork Port Stephens strongly requests that the IPC thoroughly investigates and considers the **Cumulative and Combined Impacts** of the many existing and proposed quarries in Port Stephens and MidCoast LGAs, prior to accepting recommendations to approve Deep Creek Quarry.

It is of serious concern to all rural communities that developments may gain approval that will have **significant impacts** on biodiversity and their own environment, their livelihoods and enjoyment of their own properties, on social amenity, road safety, collection of clean drinking water from rainfall, and critically on their health and wellbeing through stress caused by noise, dust and air pollution, all while making little economic contribution locally.

This proposal is **not in the public interest**, not in the interest of biodiversity and the survival of endangered and vulnerable species, and not in the interest of the blue water wonderland of Port Stephens waterways.
