I wish to state my concerns in regards to the planned development of the Energy to Waste Facility at Eastern Creek.

I am a mother of 3 children & I live in Plumpton. I have 2 children at school in Rooty Hill and one who works in Eastern Creek both of which are very close to the site.

I am concerned for my family and my friends as this facility if it goes ahead will be built in close proximity of schools, homes, hospitals, shops and the Prospect Reservoir.

It will emit pollution which will be harmful to the environment and to our health, releasing ash and tiny particles into the air which I am lead to believe can cause irritation and inflammation to the eyes, nose and throat. My husband and son have asthma and I am not happy about an increased risk to their condition.
