RE: Eastern Creek Energy from Waste

Dear Commissioners,

Further to my two speeches I made last Monday, I would like to add something further. Plus attach two items.

As stated in my first speech last Monday, I explained that consultation wasn't adequate. I left out that I had become aware about a meeting being held by Penrith Council on 16 February 2017. A letter had been sent to some residents. It was posted on Erskine Park/St Clair Facebook community page, and people in Erskine Park, St Clair, Colyton, etc were saying that they had not received it. The meeting was to inform the community about the EfW incinerator proposal and that there would be representatives there from TNG.

When I found about the meeting, I rang Peter Wood who is the contact on the letter. I asked him if I could attend as I was in the Blacktown Council area. He said to me that was okay, as long as all Penrith Council residents were accommodated first, which was understandable. I asked Peter how many people were notified about the meeting, as there were lots of people saying that they didn't receive a letter notifying them of the meeting. He said it was 800 residents on the Eastern side of Erskine Park. I asked why, and he said they went by the NSW Planning Department's list. This concerned me that not enough people would have been notified for this meeting or the previous and current EISs. Further to that, it seemed that not everyone living on the Eastern side of Erskine Park were notified. I know my friend who lives on Swallow Drive a few doors down from the shops and who faces the site, didn't receive a letter from the council.

With regard, to my second speech talking about the letter I received from TNG and Ian Malouf, I am not sure if I included it with the green folder that I handed to one of the secretaries on the day I made the speech. So I will attach that as well.
