

The public meeting for this project was a revolting act of disadvantage to key community stakeholders concerning this project. With regards to the public concerned in the Campbelltown area, 61.3% of the total population are employed full time according to the 2016 census data. Similarly, 61.8% of all those employed who live in Campbelltown, work outside of the city and must commute to work. Consequentially, all community members have not had fair and equal opportunity to gain more information and voice their concerns due to the timing of the community meeting. It was registered on a Monday, at 9am which denies access to majority of the total population in the relevant community.

I, Tiffany Roma are one of those people. I am opposed to the cemetery being built on the property close to the Varroville house. I believe this to be a degradation of a site which should be a heritage site. Next, I agree with the national trust that: "The cemetery does not meet a need for burial space in the Macarthur and South-West Sydney Regions", and it is ridiculous that a report released by the NSW government, "the Metropolitan Sydney Cemetery Capacity Report, a survey of available burial space in metropolitan Sydney, 2017 has found 300,000 plots available, enough for the next 34 years".

This plan does not meet the need of the people of south west Sydney and I urge that this proposal does not go ahead.
