To Whom it May Concern,

I am writing this letter in order to outline the support provided for our organisation by Glencore, and the impact that support has had on Ungooroo as an organisation and the Aboriginal community located in the Upper Hunter.

Ungooroo's relationship with Glencore spans more than ten (10) years and has always been one of mutual respect.

Some of the initiatives supported by Glencore include the following;

- Wupa@Wanaruah Aboriginal Art Exhibition & Trail – Glencore have been a major sponsor of this event, which recently celebrated it's 10th anniversary. The support provided by Glencore has enabled wupa to grow from it's initial concept, which involved 2 local Aboriginal artists, 1 venue, held over a 2 day period to the current model which includes over 15 local Aboriginal artists, 7 venues with Aboriginal art displayed all year round as part of a self-guided Art Trail. In total there have been over 30 Aboriginal artists involved, with as many as 14 different venues participating. This has allowed local artists to develop their skills and grow an awareness of local, Aboriginal culture. As a result of this support many of the artists have developed small businesses that have enabled them to generate a sustainable income from local, national and international sales. The ongoing support of Glencore has played a major part in the development and success of our event and local Aboriginal artists.
- Dental Clinic – Glencore have supported Ungooroo in the development of and delivery of Oral health and Dental programs to local Aboriginal students. In conjunction with other bodied Glencore assisted with the set-up of a fully equipped and functioning Dental van and onsite sterilisation unit. Services provided as a result of this support include;
 - Dental care and relationship work between patients and children
 - Check-ups and future dental plans for under 18
 - Preventative care and cleans for children
 - All ages dental care for up to 18
 - School screenings**The results are found not just in the oral health but improved health outcomes overall from regular dental checks.**
- Glencore have also provided valuable financial support that was instrumental in the set up and infrastructure costs for Ungooroo GP & Health Services. That funding and support also assisted us in achieving our accreditation through AGPAL as a General Practice, which has enabled the Ungooroo to provide a range of Health services for the Aboriginal community in the Upper Hunter.

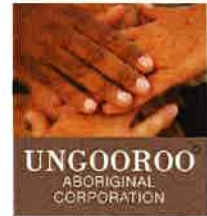
