



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS
NSW PLANNING ASSESSMENT COMMISSION
The Metropolitan Coal Project at Helensburgh

The Honourable Kristina Keneally (MP), Minister for Planning, pursuant to section 23D(1)(b)(ii) and Schedule 3 of the *NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 and Part 16(B) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000*, has directed a Planning Assessment Commission to be constituted to assess the project application for the Metropolitan Coal Project located in Helensburgh.

The terms of reference for the Commission are:

- (a) *“to carry out a review of the potential subsidence related impacts of the Metropolitan Coal Project on the drinking water catchment, and in particular the Waratah Rivulet and Woronora Reservoir, taking into consideration the recommendations of the Southern Coalfields Inquiry;*
- (b) *advise on the significance and acceptability of these potential impacts, and to recommend appropriate measures to avoid, minimise, or offset these impacts; and identify; and*
- (c) *comment on any other significant issues raised in submissions regarding the Metropolitan Coal Project or during the public hearings”.*

The Minister has also directed that public hearings be held into the project. The hearings will commence at **9:30am on Wednesday, 11 March 2009** and continue if required at **Wollongong City Council Chambers, 41 Burelli Street, Wollongong**. The hearings will be open to the public.

All previous submissions made to the Department of Planning have been forwarded to the Commission for its consideration.
