Dear Sirs

As residents of Jerrys Plains we have already submitted our objection to the proposed Drayton South Project. We now feel compelled to add further to that submission due to new mine activity by Wambo Mine to the south of Jerrys Plains. As already outlined we suffer impacts from the super pit at HVO which is visible from our property to the South East and which has worsened over the years. However it is the new activity at Wambo within the past 10 days that has caused us great distress as it is clearly visible from our living room. The photos attached document clearly what our future looks like. What is even more distressing is that this 'new extension' comes ahead of the application for the extension on the southern end at the old United Colliery site (for which a PAC hearing was held in Singleton last week) and worse still there is a Glencore Wambo Joint Venture application for another extension which is at the "Response to Submissions" stage. This JV proposal will operate adjacent to the new activity which is already clearly visible.

As the Drayton South proposal is to the North of Jerrys Plains, we are sure you will appreciate our concerns and objections which are based on our experiences and supported by the photo evidence. On the 5 November Wambo was undertaking work in unsuitable conditions resulting in significant dust issues. When we complained to Wambo the response we received was that they "have approval from the Government to operate".

We respectfully ask that when you are assessing the application before you, please bear in mind the existing mining activity in the area together with the other proposals already under submission. The photos attached show the results of approvals and what we are condemned to live with every day.
