Dear David

I refer to your letter dated 23 May 2018 seeking clarification as to when and how the Applicant, The Next Generation, for the proposed energy from waste facility at Eastern Creek, has formally sought to amend their development application to remove floc waste from the facility's waste stream.

The Applicant's Response to Submissions (RTS) report states that the proposed design fuel for the facility will contain approximately 15% floc waste. The Department has not received any request from the Applicant to amend the application to remove floc waste from the waste stream since lodgement of the RTS and the finalisation of the Department's assessment report and recommendation.
