

Varroville Cemetery – Analysis of Public Submissions

The Crown DA was publicly exhibited by Council for an extended period from 7 November 2017 to 23 March 2018. A total of 73 submissions were received, including six from public authorities and 67 from the public. Of the 67 public submissions received, 37 objected and 30 wrote in support of the proposal.

Concerns raised in the submissions include:

- potential impacts on heritage values and the Varroville Homestead
- conservation, tree removal and loss of green space
- permissibility
- visual amenity
- project need
- traffic, parking and road infrastructure
- social and economic
- noise
- the public interest
- procedural matters associated with Council’s management of the DA.

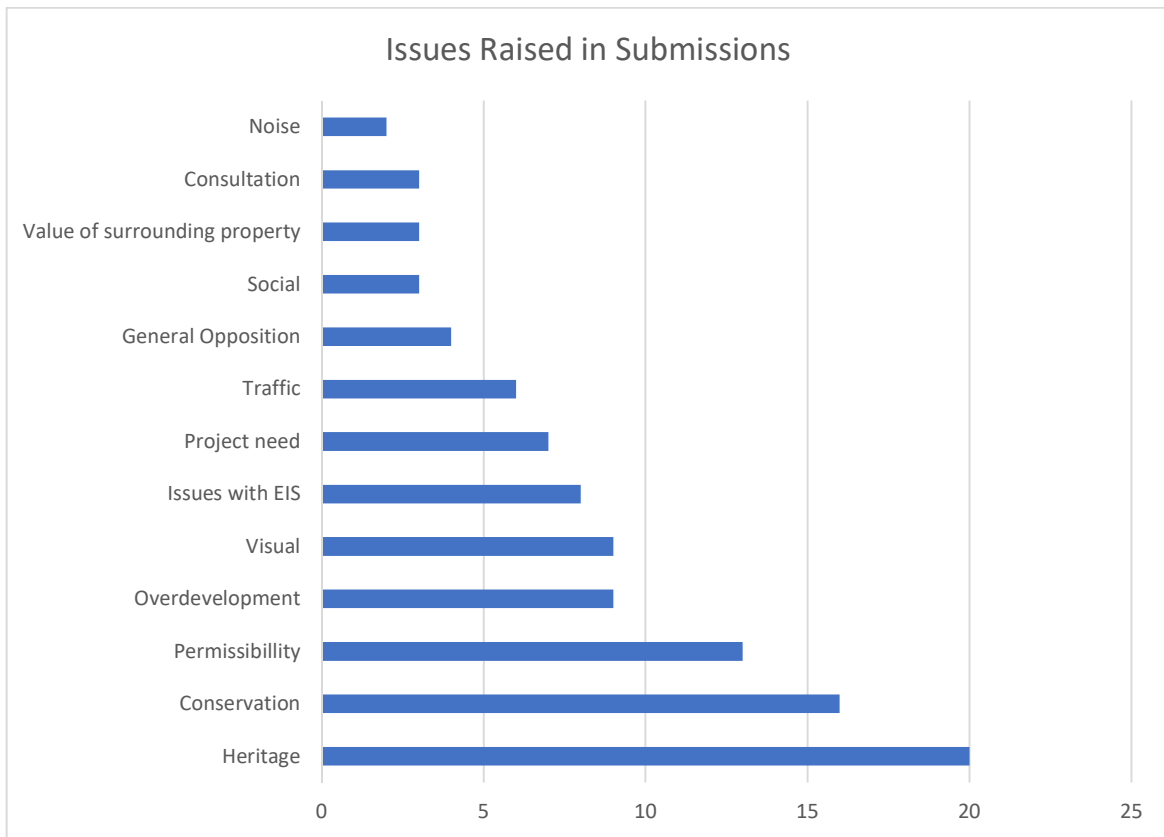


Figure 1: Key issues identified in objecting submissions

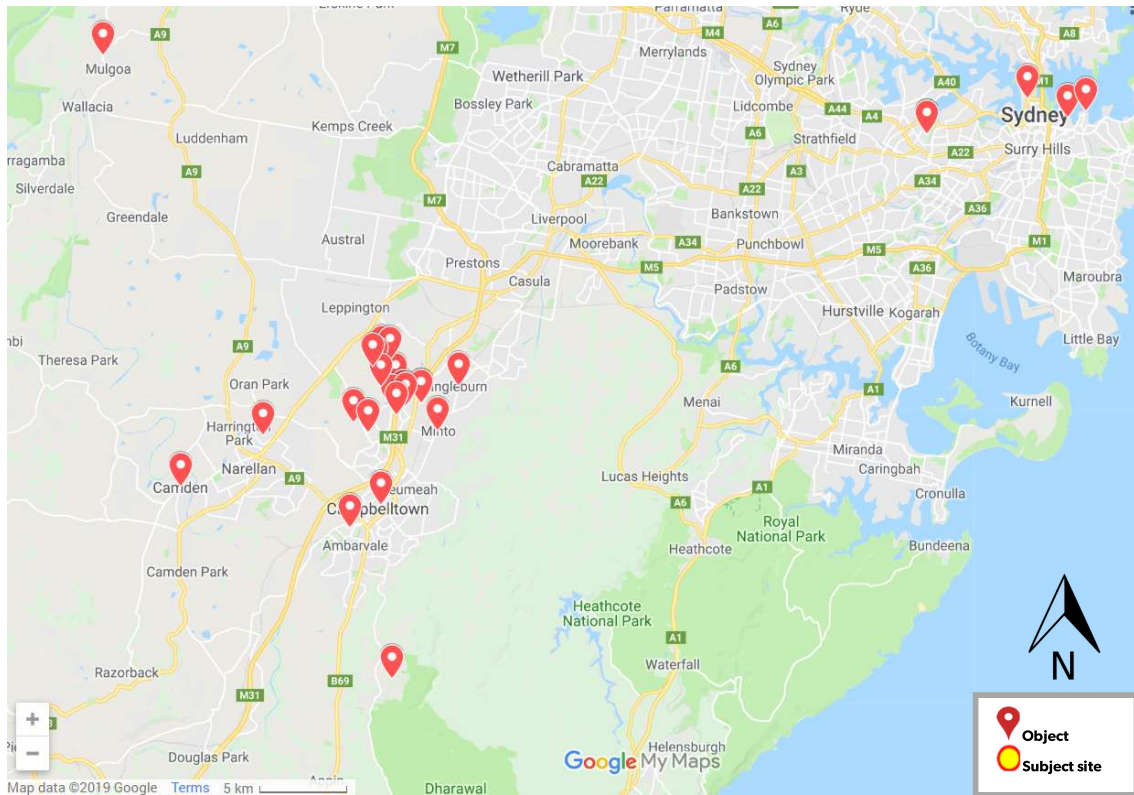


Figure 2: An indicative representation of the location of objecting submissions

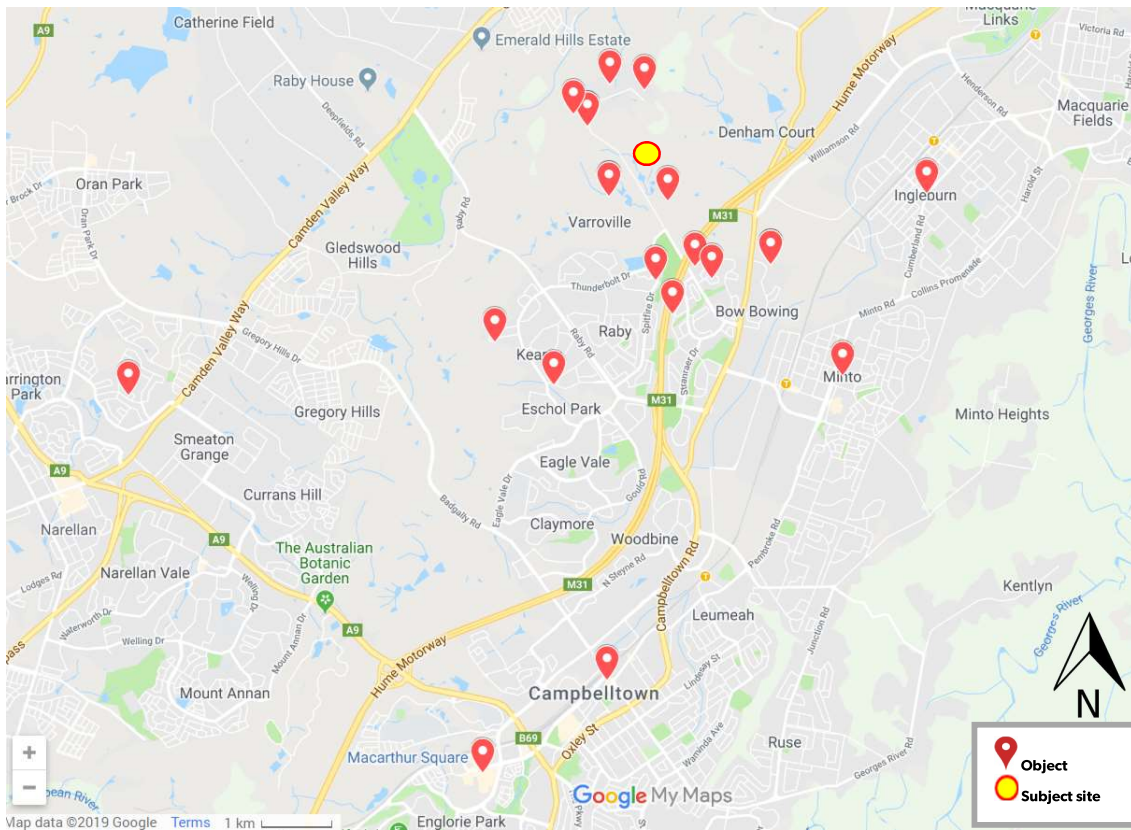


Figure 3: An indicative representation of the location of objecting submissions

The proportion of submissions that raised key issues within the objecting submissions is provided within **Figure 1**. An indicative representation of the locality of the objecting submissions is shown on **Figure 2** and **Figure 3**.

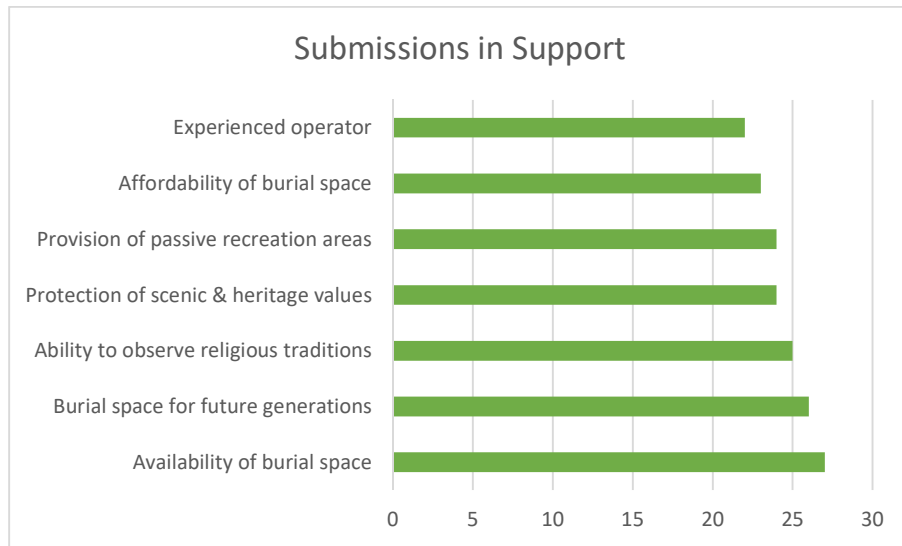


Figure 4: Summary of reasons given in support of the application

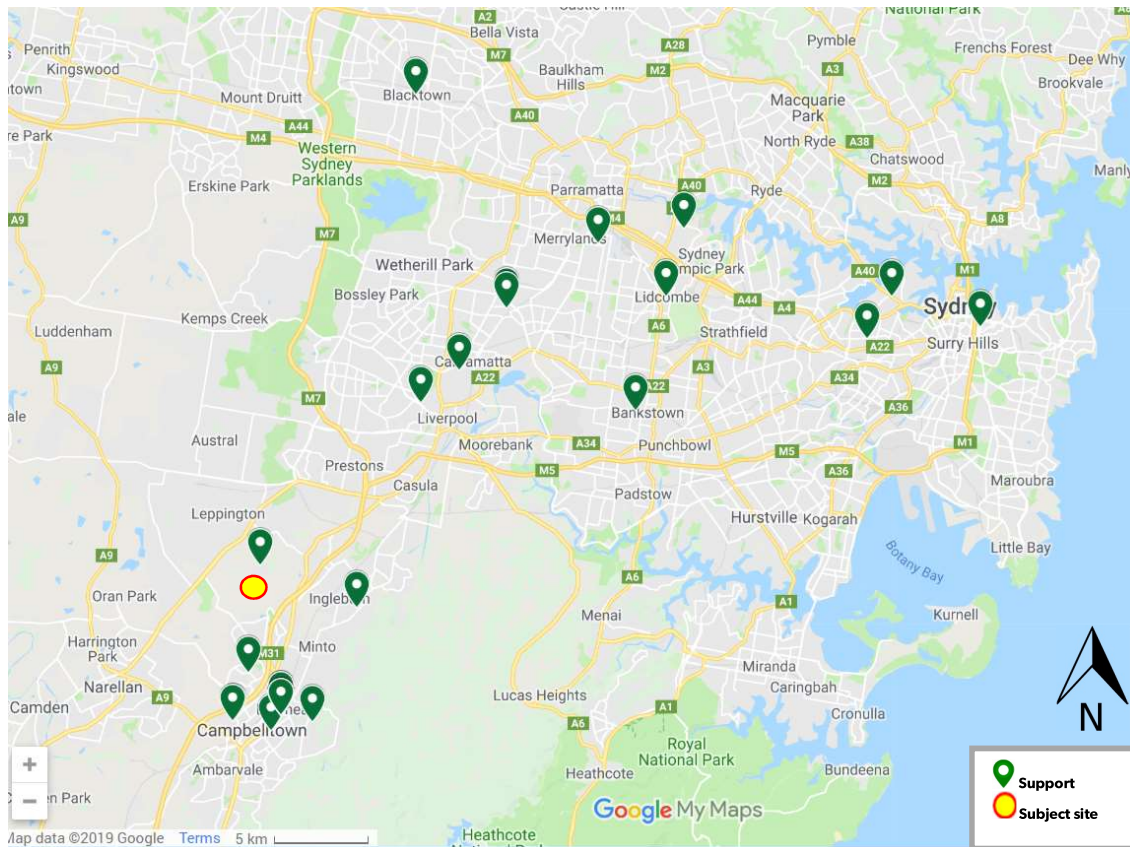


Figure 5: An indicative representation of the location of supporting submissions

Figure 4 depicts a summary of reasons given in support of the application. An indicative representation of the location of the submissions in support are shown on **Figure 5**.
