Hi Sally,
The suggestion by Acoustic Studio to effectively half the traffic passing the Retreat by use of both A and B options seems to be the most reasonable and feasible option to reduce the traffic noise. I would flag that in regards to noise policy, there is no additional consideration given to heritage properties such as Varroville House. The fact that it is privately owned further reduces any further consideration as the benefits would only apply to one family, and it is not open to the public.
In the end you will need to weigh up these considerations, but I would be recommending the suggestion by Acoustic Studio as being reasonable and feasible.
