Updates after project commencement:

On 4 February 2019, Ross Carter disclosed that he had a professional connection with the company Alluvium, who had been engaged by Warren Smiths and Associates, the applicant's civil engineer, to prepare the Water Cycle Management Plan as an appendix (October 2017 - App Q) to the original DA lodged with Council.

Mr Carter was appointed to an independent expert panel to undertake a review of aspects of the administration the Snowy Hydro water licence in October 2018. The Department of Industry engaged the company Alluvium to convene and support the independent expert panel. This included Mr Carter invoicing Alluvium who paid his fee, but then invoiced the Department of Industry.

The Commission finds this is not a breach of the Commission's Conflict of Interest Policy, nor does it prevent Mr Carter from sitting on the panel.
