In addition to my earlier submission, I wish to refute the statement recorded at the IPC meeting held at Pyramul on the 11 Jun regarding the impact on the Koala's population by the proposed clearing of trees along Aarons Pass road as part of the road upgrade as recommended by MWRC.

As a permanent resident of the past 20 years and a constant user of the road day or night, I have not experienced any evidence of Koalas adjacent to or on the road verges.

I note however, the only indication of any presence of Koalas in the vicinity of Aarons Pass road is a Koala road sign located towards the Pyramul end of the road which has been there since us taking up residency on Aarons Pass.

I fully support the proposed upgrading of Aarons Pass Road MOD1
