My name is Colin James, My Wife and I live in very close proximity to the existing White Rock Wind farm (stage one) We have endured many nights of disturbed sleep from the turbines noise at night due to them emitting, what is known as Low Frequency noise, this form of noise does not dissipate through the air as does dB noise does, which is the measure turbines are (unsatisfactorily) tested on at the moment.

Recently the WHO (world health organisation) released an updated report into the effects of wind turbine noise, finding the ill effects on humans exposed to low frequency noise to be of much concern,

With relation to (White Rock Wind farm), They have been an organisation that has been (far) from telling the truth to people, they have not done many of the required work's they were meant to do, they caused much land degradation.
