I am writing to object to the NARRABRI ^{today's} (date = 11.7.2020) GAS PROJECT because I believe GAS wells in our REGION could damage our water supply and our way of LIFE. We are still here at AVOCA because of our access to Artesian Water. Our family has owned AVOCA Gulargambone (Coonamble shire) since about 1860. My great grandfather William Moore Connell, put down 2 Artesian bores at AVOCA in early 1900. We have use of one of these BORES on our part of AVOCA. THIS BORE WAS OUR ONLY SOURCE of WATER for STOCK when the LAST of our 18 DAMS DRIED up on 20 JANUARY 2019. Our manager's house was THEN completely ARTESIAN, even the drinking water. OUR ONE ARTESIAN BORE, PLUS TANKS, TROUGHS, PIPING and a SOLAR PUMP ALLOWED US to KEEP OUR SHEEP (2000 head) and a skeleton mob of 80 STUB MURRAY GREY BEEF COWS and

SEVERAL Bulls. We had to sell the heart of my stud cattle (403 head) in early 2019, due to feed costs and the worries about our water supply.

Down-filling rains began on 18 February 2020 and our world thankfully turned from dust to green.

Three years of awful drought is so bad for one's mental health.

Damage to our Artesian water supply would cripple many families like us, particularly as we do NOT CROP
Ja.
