Dear IPC Chair

I am responding to the upcoming public meeting being held by the Independent Planning Commission NSW to listen to our community's views on the proposed Greenwich Hospital Redevelopment.

As a health professional I have serious concerns about this proposed development, in particular the fact that the size and scale of it will erode the potential use of this site as a hospital facility into the future.

Further there is already a plethora of other aged care developments in the pipeline, existing/approved and/or under way in this local government area that require examination. It is paramount that Greenwich Hospital be retained as a zoned health facility and its role not be eroded.

Accordingly, there is a need for further significant reduction in the size and scale of the proposal. Public palliative care and rehabilitation are much needed and should be enhanced and expanded.

I ask that the IPC take the issues I have raised into consideration in making its decision on the Greenwich Hospital development proposal.
