Hi Steve,

I am a consultant assisting the Independent Planning Commission with the Dendrobium Extension Project.

Thank you for the Department's time last Monday morning with the Independent Planning Commission. It was a very worthwhile and informative meeting.

During the meeting, the Department offered to provide further information generally as follows:

- Some work was done by DPIE Water to calculate what would be the appropriate figures for us for the Voluntary Planning Agreement (Water Quantity Component). The retail IPART figure for both wet years and dry years – factors in climate variation – was used and the models used in the EIS for prediction, which are conservative, and we can go in to those – over the life of the project and then beyond the life of the project many decades post-mining. So that's an offer by the applicant on the table. In terms of the calculations that went in to that, DPIE can provide further information.

Could you please confirm the above and indicate when the Department can provide the information to the IPC.
