I object to the Dendrobium Extension Project SSD 8194

As a resident of Campbelltown for 40 years I strenuously object to the extension of the Dendrobium coal mine for the following reasons:-

1. The project as proposed will cause irreversible damage to precious natural habitat such as upland swamps. It will degrade the quality of natural areas used by local residents for recreation and threaten native species.
2. The project threatens the reliability and quality of greater Sydney's water supply.
3. I have witnessed first hand the loss of water flow in the upper Georges and Cataract Rivers and the draining of Thirlmere Lakes as a result of adjacent long wall coal mining.
4. The project could burden future generations in perpetuity with outflows polluted by heavy metals such as iron and arsenic.
5. The project is of dubious economic value as demonstrated by the precarious financial situation of the neighbouring Peabody Energy mine.
