



PROPOSED LISTING OF NORTH SYDNEY'S MLC BUILDING ON STATE HERITAGE REGISTER

The Independent Planning Commission has been asked to provide advice to the Minister responsible for the *Heritage Act 1977* on the proposed listing of the MLC Building, North Sydney, on the State Heritage Register.

The Commission will accept public submissions in relation to this matter up until 5pm AEDT on Thursday 1 April 2021.
