Hello,

As a resident of Jackson's Landing I would like to register my objection to the construction and subsequent operation of the above mentioned facility in its proposed location.

My objections centre around the issues of noise and air pollution, and proposed 24/7 operation of the plant. I am concerned that monitoring systems are grossly underestimated and could allow non-compliance on many levels.

Personally I do NOT want the fresh air and peaceful enjoyment of my locality to be compromised by the negative impacts of this development i.e. dust, air pollution, noise pollution, water pollution and associated problems around traffic, future public access across Glebe Island Bridge and Heritage concerns. These are not "trivial" concerns.

There are too many opportunities to damage the health and well-being of the communities closest to this proposed development.

I foresee that many people will have contaminated lungs and sleepless nights as well as encountering reduced peacefulness if this facility is allowed to operate as per its proposal.

The 24/7 operation of the facility is a major concern for residents' daily existence and is being argued as supporting historical foreshore harbour activities.

I hereby lodge my disappointment and objection to the Hanson Proposal.
