I just saw this response from Hanson on the photo montages. Again, like so many other things, this is misleading. The camera lens used for the middle photo gives a completely inaccurate idea of the actual view from that point on Pirrama Park. If the Commissioners go to that point, they will see that the proposed site appears much closer and larger than the Hanson photo suggests. Similarly, the proposed plant would look much larger in reality than the Hanson photomontage indicates.

The photomontage attempts to downplay the true visual impact and in particular the blocking of views to the ANZAC bridge. At best, this is disingenuous of Hanson.
