Harbourside Shopping Centre Redevelopment (SSD 7874)

I refer to the Public Meeting held by the Independent Planning Commission (**Commission**) for the above application on 28 April 2021.

In relation to the Ferris wheel located on the Darling Harbour western foreshore, to the east of the Harbourside Shopping Centre, and as discussed at the Public Meeting - the Commission is aware that there is a current application with Council for a larger Ferris wheel.

At the Public Meeting, the Applicant stated:

“as I understand it, hasn’t been granted landowner’s consent by the landowner, being Place Management” (Public Meeting Transcript, page P-16)

Consequently, the Commission requests the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (**Department**) provide the following information:

1. Confirmation as to whether Place Management have granted landowner’s consent to the proposed larger Ferris wheel currently being considered by Council; and
2. In the circumstances that Place Management have not granted landowner’s consent for the proposed larger Ferris wheel, the timeframe within which Place Management will decide whether to grant landowner’s consent.
