Mr Wilson has disclosed that prior to 2015 he was involved with the regulation of previous operations at the site as an officer of the Department of Planning and Environment. Mr Wilson has not (previously to his present appointment to the Panel) exercised any decision-making functions in relation to the application.

The Chair of the Commission has determined, consistent with the Commission's *Conflict of Interest* policy, that Mr Wilson's disclosure does not preclude his appointment to the present Panel.

Mr Cochrane has withdrawn from the Panel due to scheduling conflicts.

Updates after project commencement:

Professor Barlow has informed the Chair that he is an acquaintance of an objector to the application. Professor Barlow became aware of this when the objector attended the Panel's locality tour as a community participant. Professor Barlow has no professional or close personal relationship with the objector and the acquaintance is based on the objector's previous employment in the field of agricultural education prior to 2015. Professor Barlow has never had any regular, ongoing communications with the objector. The Chair of the Commission has determined that there is no actual or potential conflict of interest and that Professor Barlow may remain appointed to the Panel for this matter.
