The response from Daracon has been pathetic at best. 24 truck movements per hour is still one truck movement every 2.5 minutes which is absolutely ludicrous to even suggest. The village is not a "Quiet" village as daracon claims. It's a bustling centre for locals and the population has increased significantly in Vacy, Paterson, Largs, Martins Creek etc since Daracon purchased the mine and during the years of their illegal haulages. King street and the road through the park will become a thoroughfare for traffic trying to avoid the build up on Paterson road. This occurred during the period when daracon were transporting product illegally and it was a total nightmare for residents and people using the park. The argument that the state rail transported similar haulages is not relevant as that was many years ago when the village had far fewer residents. The quarry was purchased as a mainly ballast quarry and the public should not be penalised and inconvenienced because the quarry owner now wishes to change the purpose of the quarry.

I would also like to mention that many people are being excluded from making a submission because either they don't have an email address, the timing means a lot of people are either on holidays or are busy getting children organised for school and having to read a 51 page submission plus attachments takes time. I would hate to see this development pushed through before the government goes to an election.
