It's not a house. It's a home.

Just before Christmas, the Coalition backflipped on numerous commitments to our community about reining in short-term rental accommodation in Byron Shire. They did this the day before our councillors voted unanimously to lower the number of days those whole homes can be let in most of the shire from 180 days per year to 90 days.



This backflip had to be due to pressure from powerful vested interests, as I was given commitments by the current and former premiers of NSW that we would be able to rein in holiday letting in Byron Shire, where the council has been progressing this issue since 2003.

The IPC (Independent Planning Commission) will now intervene to 'provide advice' to the government on 'whether the government should allow the proposed changes to go forward'.
