My family's objection centres on the grounds of the increased noise, traffic and obstruction during its proposed construction.

My elderly mother who lives largely independently in the home relies heavily on the essential services available in he Nundle village.

She can only access these and her social connections, that are vital for her well being, via crawney road and the village streets that are going to be severely affected by the associated construction traffic.

With the increased daily light traffic movement rising by 35% and the daily incidence of oversized/over mass vehicles being as many as 6/day, this poses a real risk to her well being.

The traffic effectively makes a trip to the village a punishment to run the gauntlet. Travelling from her home to her critical services is a heightened risk and concern for her and family. It needlessly puts her independence under unnecessary pressure.
