## **VISUAL AMENITY**

"The Project" moves through, and sits on, a beautiful and



dramatic natural landscape: river flats, undulating land, mountains and villages.

- Visual amenity is multi-dimensional, changing with location – lookouts, ridges, outcrops, low land.
- Now it is picturesque.
- Future will be scoured by roads and swathes of bare land for all manner of access and infrastructure.



## **BIODIVERSITY**



- Biodiversity Offsets DO NOT mitigate the REAL LOSSES – they appease – through legislation.
  What is lost cannot be put back.
- Threatened flora and fauna need their unique locations and symbiotic relationships to survive.
- Economic benefit versus biodiversity destruction.

## THEM and US? or... THEM vs US?

- Government Mandates community consultation; least environmental impact.
- **EnergyCo** social licence central to delivery of REZ, electricity infrastructure and enabling legislation.
- **DPIE** projects must work closely with communities → build in right place to COMPLEMENT land use (which includes recreation and biodiversity).
