I am writing to strongly object to the proposed Plasrefine Recycling Facility in Moss Vale. This project poses serious risks to our community and environment.

Environmental and Health Risks:

The facility's location within Sydney's drinking water catchment raises concerns about potential water pollution and air quality deterioration from its 24/7 operations.

We know Medical Insurance companies have the actuarials about elevated levels of serious health issues around industrial manufacturing such as refining plastic.

This will lower property values in the area and eventually increase private Health Insurance premiums and the burden on our local medical system. Community Opposition:

Flawed Process:

The lack of transparency in the approval process and disregard for local planning priorities are deeply troubling.
