I register my objection to Moss Vale Plastic Recycling facility for reasons outlined below.

Although I am not a resident of the Moss Vale area, I am a frequent visitor to the town and surrounding areas. I very much enjoy the rural aspect of the area, and placing a massive plastic recycling facility in a semi rural/residential area seems totally out of place. I have concerns about the impact of the facility on the health and well-being of local residents, human and animal.. Will it impact air quality?

I also have concerns about plastic seeping into local rivers and other water supply which would impact the quality of water for domestic and commercial use (such as the quality of drinking water for residents and hospitality concerns such as cafes.
