We're holding a Public Meeting to listen to the community's views

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry & Environment has now completed its evaluation of the proposed **Pindimar Abalone Farm (SSD 7265)** and provided it to the Independent Planning Commission NSW for determination.

To ensure interested individuals and/or groups can still have their say on the Pindimar Abalone Farm, the Commission will conduct a public meeting remotely by video conference (with an option to participate by telephone).

Commissioners Dianne Leeson (Panel Chair) and Peter Cochrane have been appointed to determine this state significant development application. They will host this electronic Public Meeting from **9am AEST on Tuesday 6 July 2021** to hear directly from community members.

If you wish to apply to speak at the electronic Public Meeting, you must complete the **registration form** on our website by no later than **12pm AEST on Wednesday 30 June 2021**. Once speakers who wish to participate in the Public Meeting are registered, the Commission will provide additional information about the technical details and process to assist them.
