

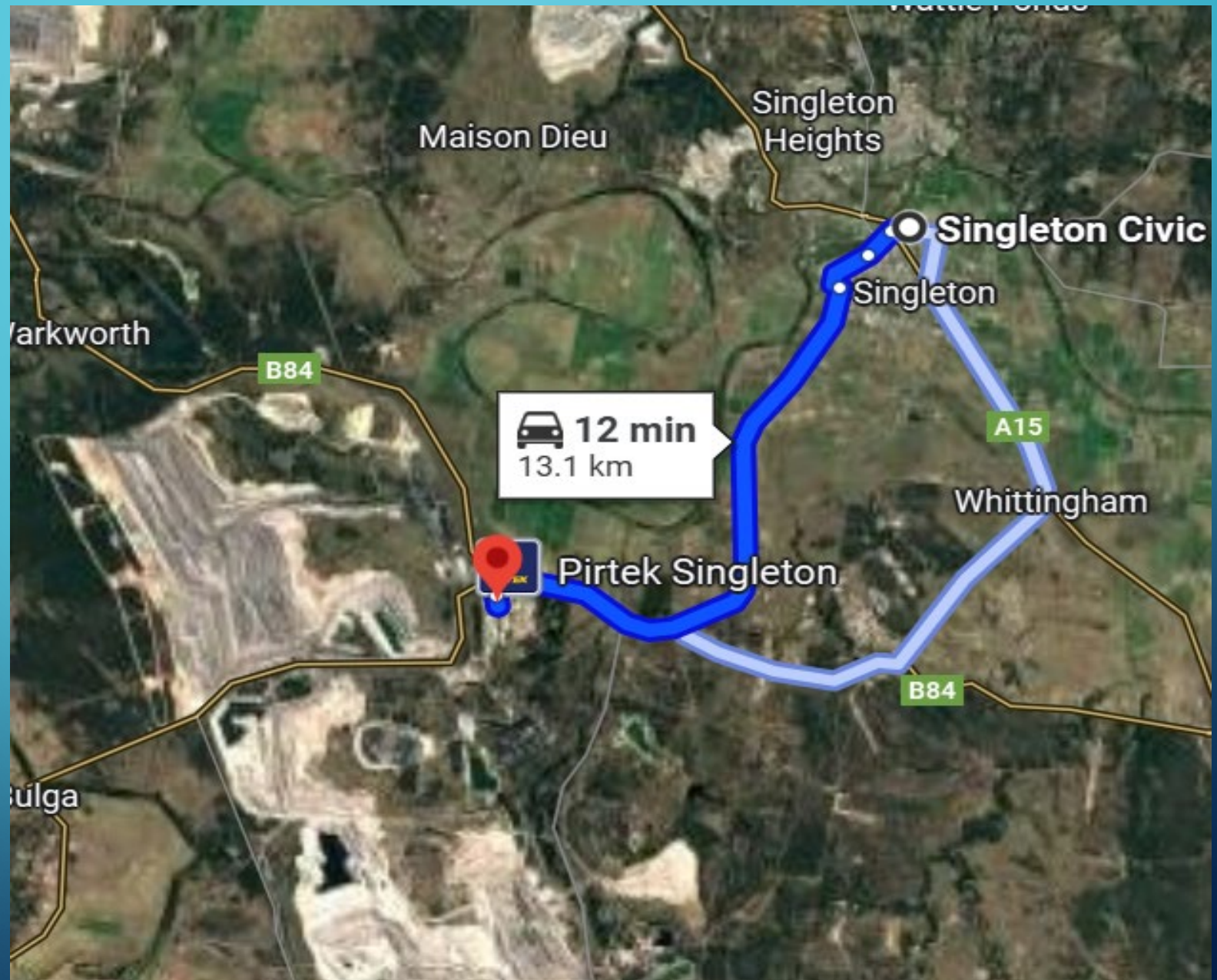

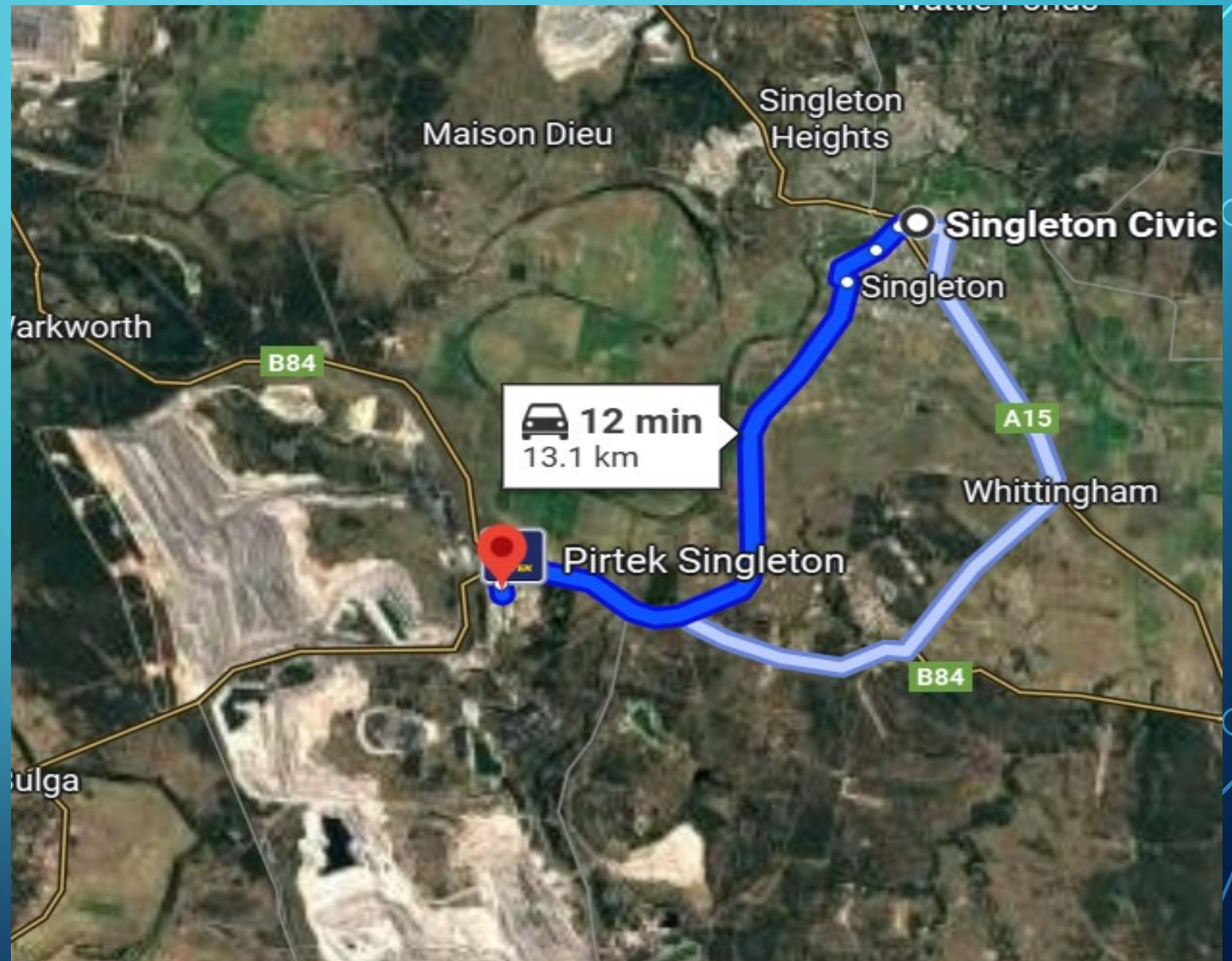

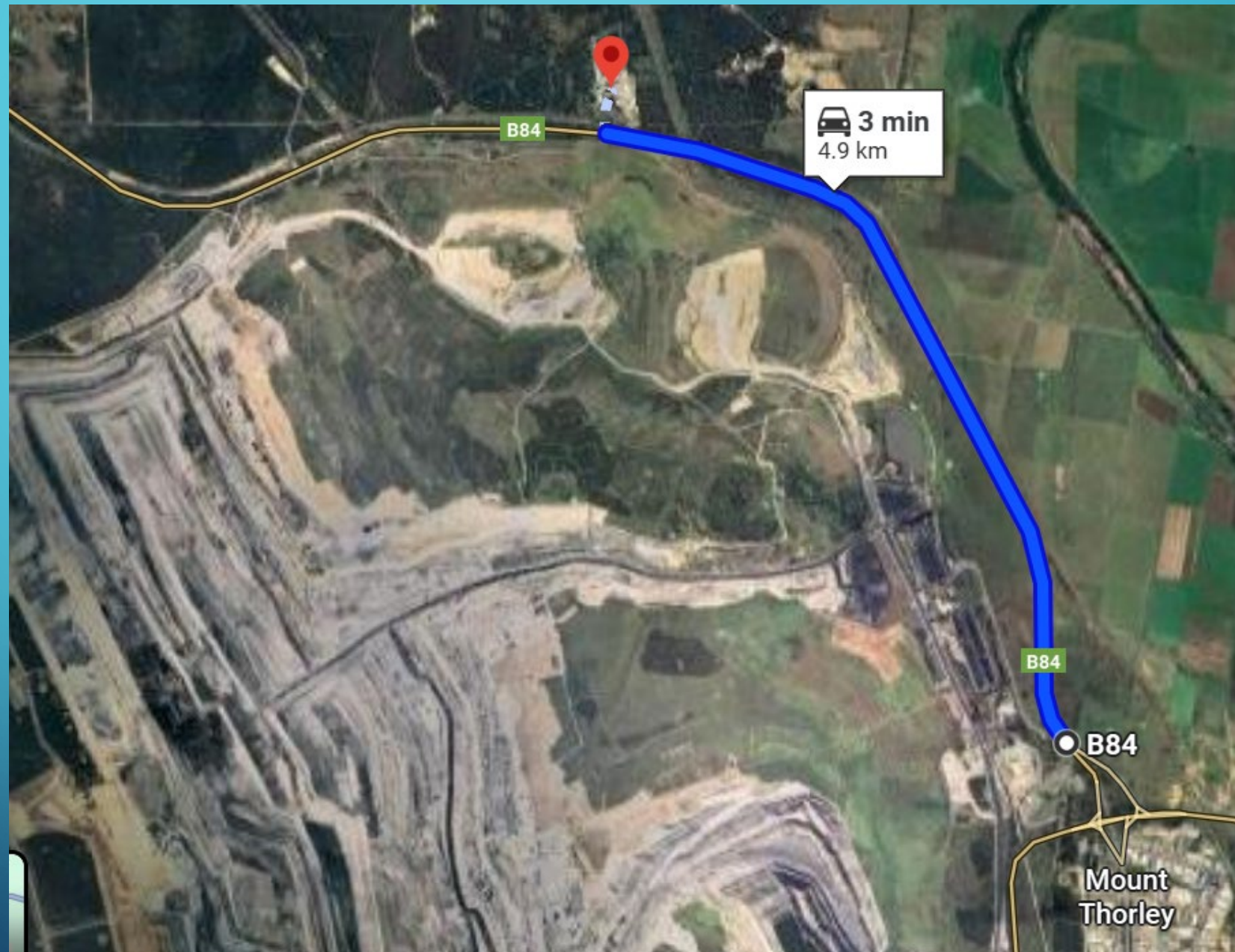

There was no government department consultation regarding activities within A444 during the reporting period. Consultation in future reporting periods will be summarised in *Table 2*.

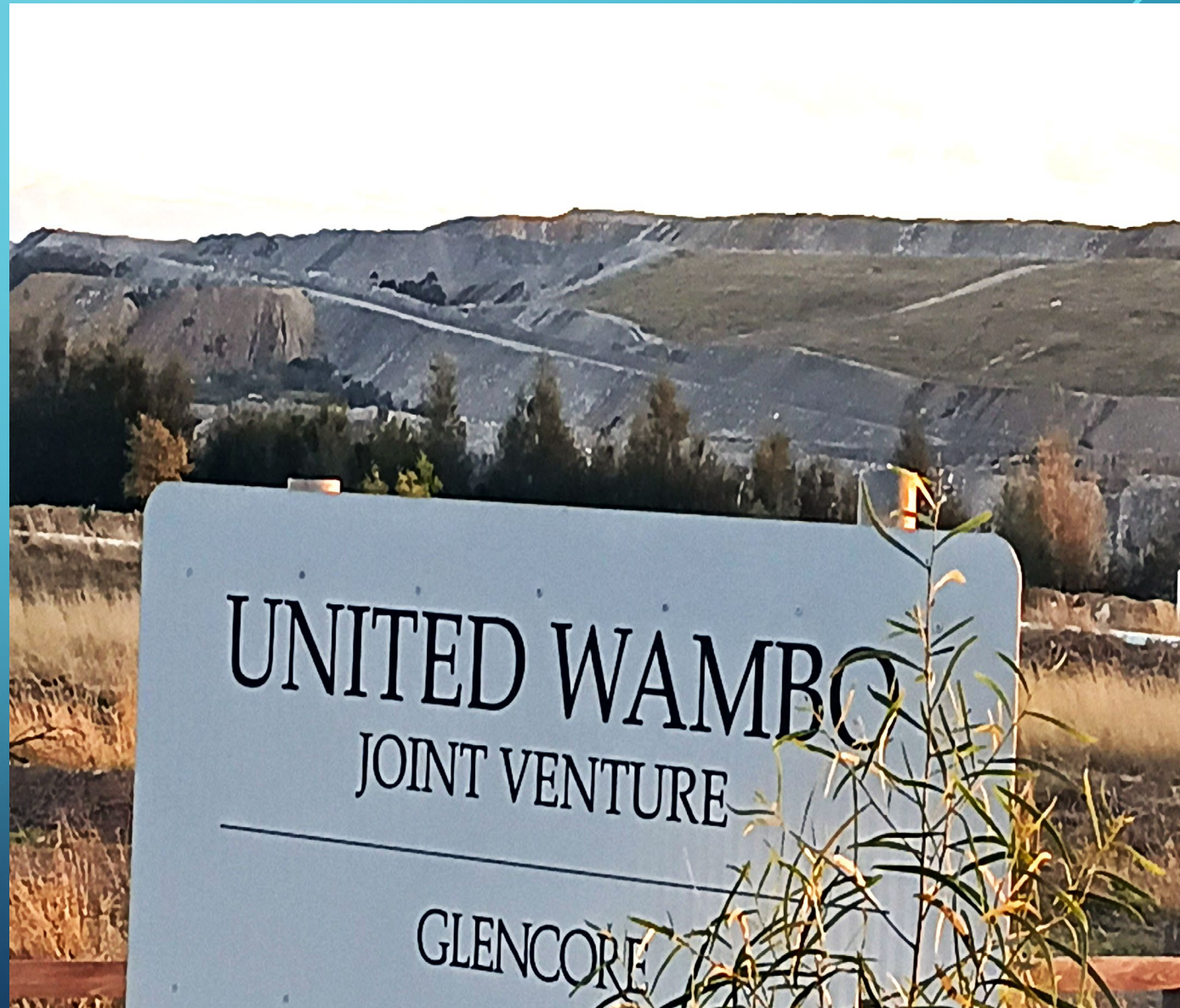

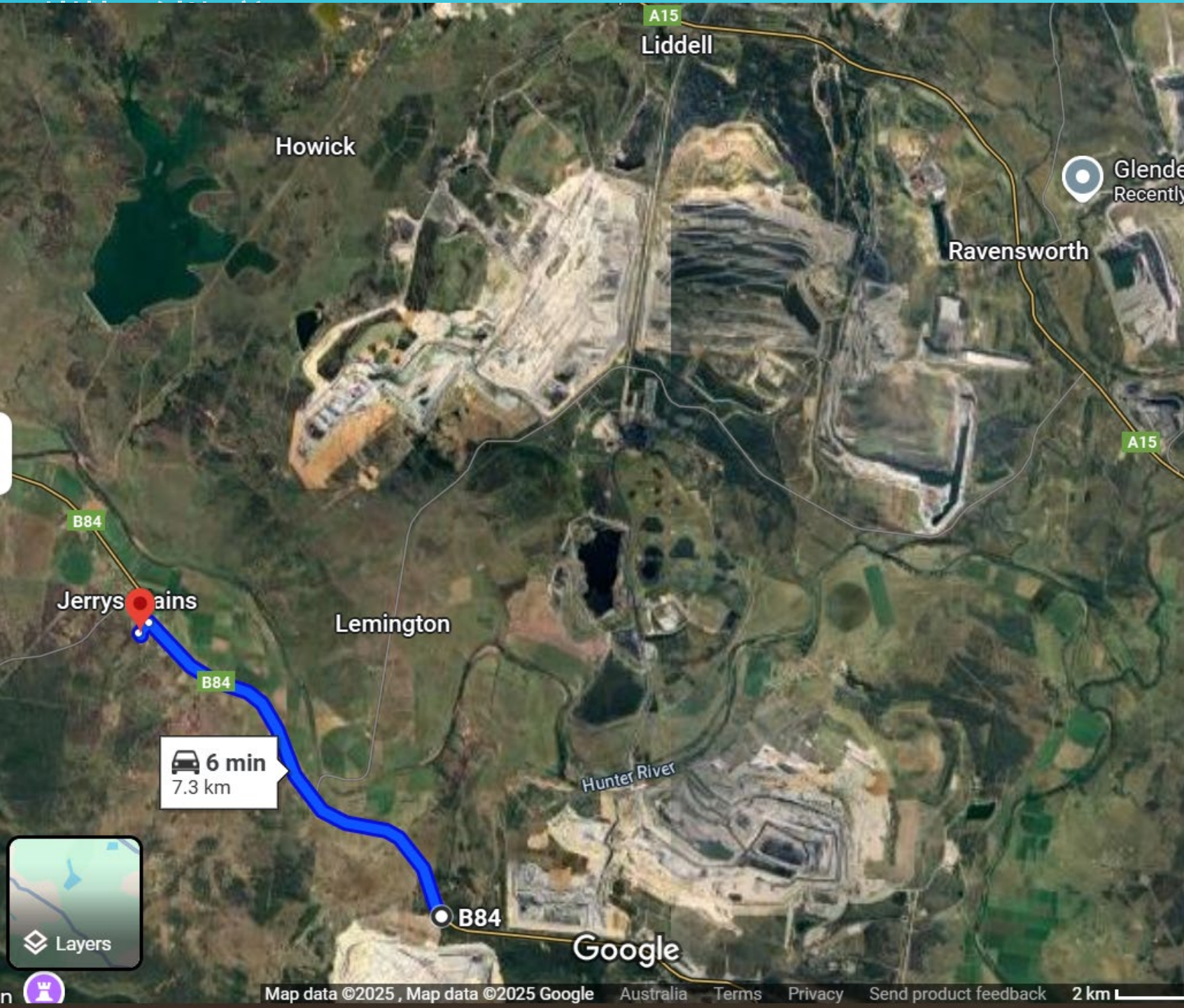

Mount Thorley Warkworth Blasting Schedule

4 August 2025 - 10 August 2025

Mt Thorley Warkworth is permitted to undertake temporary road closures of Putty Road, Charlton Road, Gouldsville Road and the Golden Highway or combinations thereof for purposes of blasting.
The objective of these road closures is to ensure public safety during blast events which have the potential to affect public roads

4/08/2025 to 10/08/2025

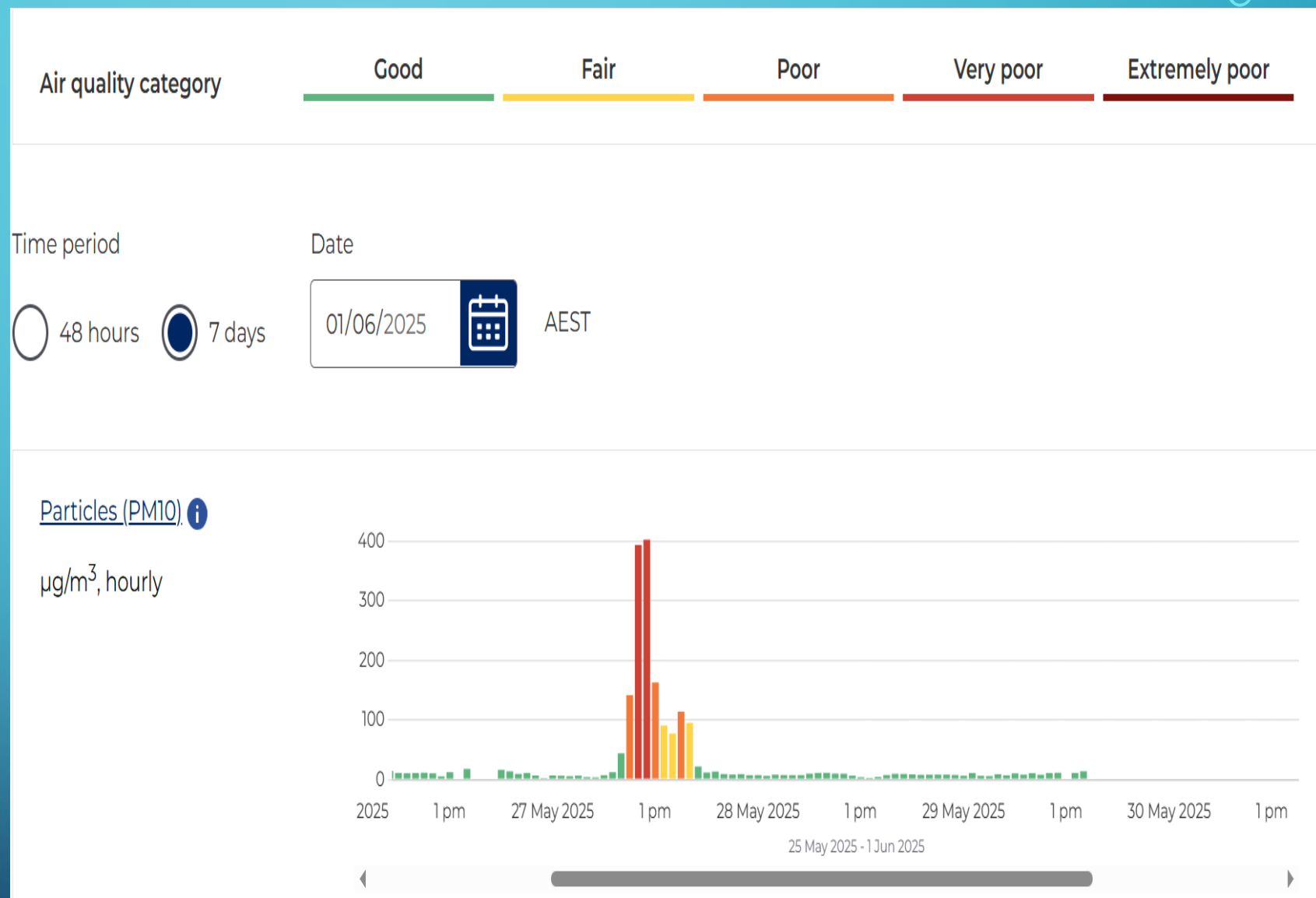

The firing window is between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm.

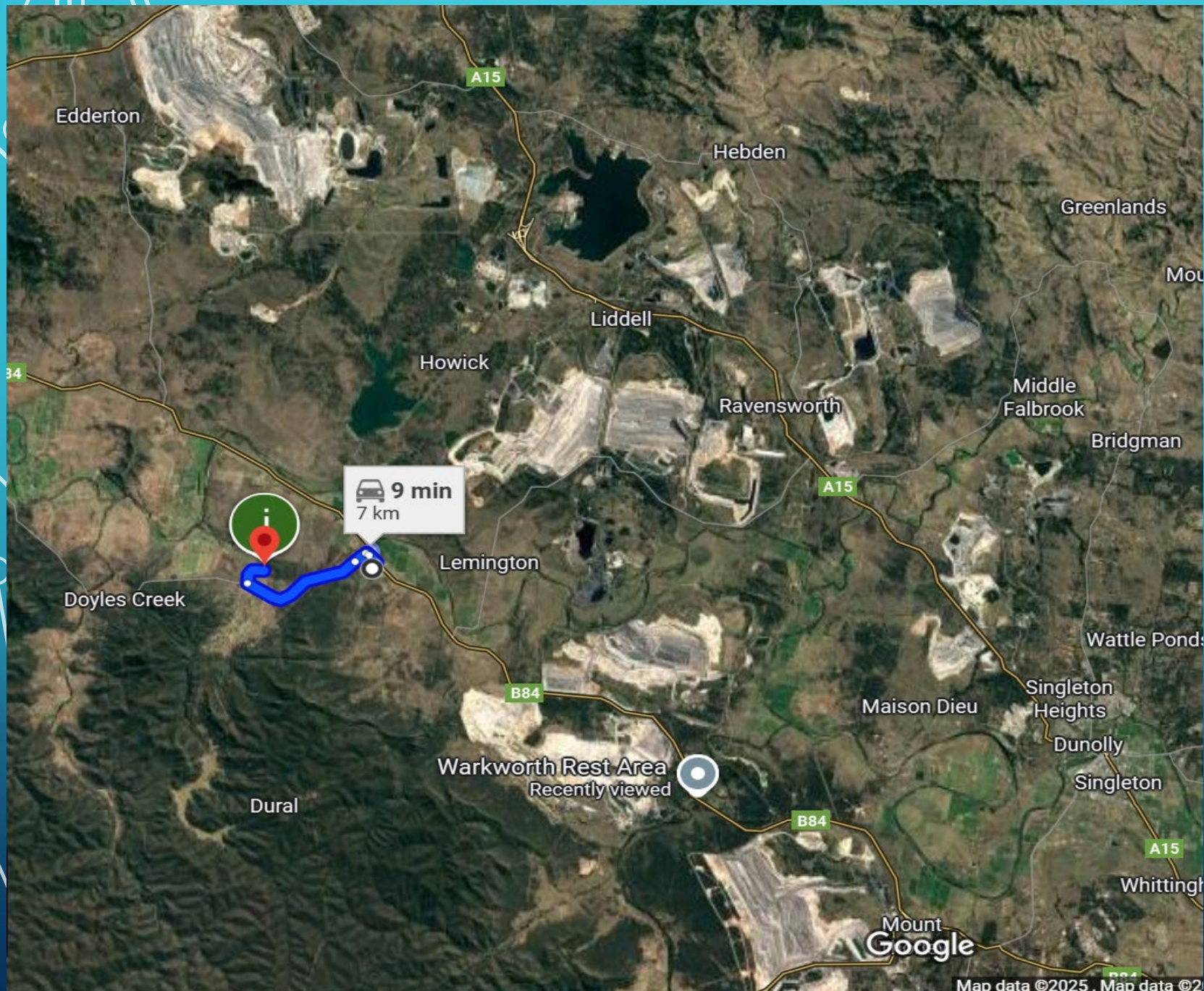

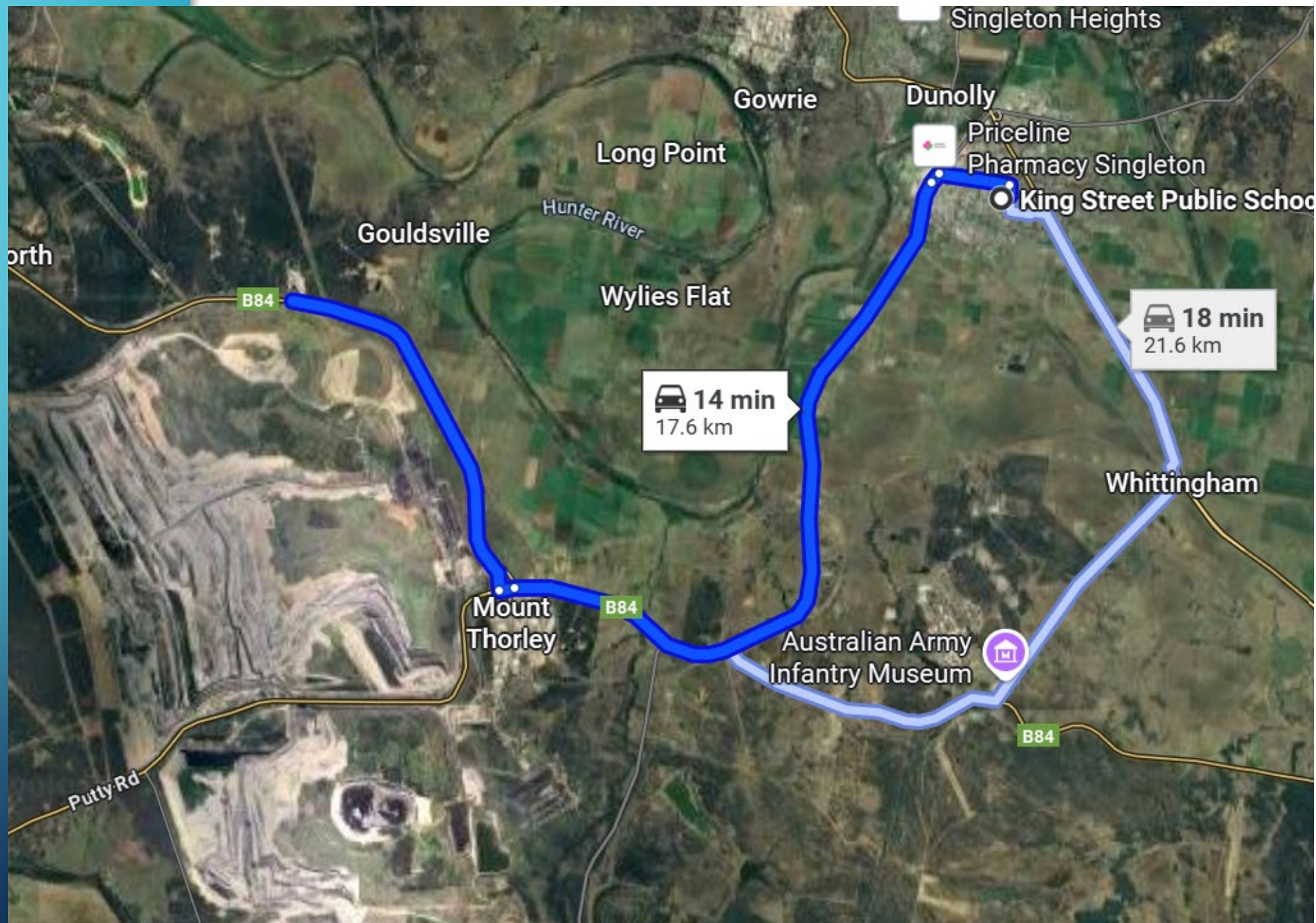
