



continue their cultural practice of burial over cremation. This proposal will provide much needed multidenominational cemetery space in south west Sydney

As the population of south west Sydney continues to grow and more people move into the area, so will the need for burial space, as well as parklands that can be accessed by all in the community. After viewing the plans, I am confident this development will provide burial space for the next 100 years and will be a respected use of the Scenic Hills. It will also provide passive recreational areas, gardens and landscaped walkways for all in the community to enjoy.

In September 2016, the Joint Regional Planning Panel unanimously approved the development citing several reasons including demand for further cemetery space in the greater Macarthur area.

"The proposal includes a large area of attractive open space that will be accessible to the public and provide opportunities to experience the scenic qualities and vistas of the locality and believes this will be a substantial public benefit given that no public access is currently available to the subject land."

"The panel believes the proposed proposal has been specifically designed such that it will not harm the area's visual, cultural and environmental qualities and will act to protect these values in perpetuity,"

Catholic Cemeteries are committed to protecting the beauty and heritage of this site and to providing this essential infrastructure for south west Sydney. The proposal is well overdue, so residents of Macarthur have access to an attractive memorial park with first class facilities in their local community.
