I am a resident of the Wallacia. I am opposed to the Wallacia Cemetery proposal.

I want to your attention which I believes seems to have been overlooked, which I am not sure if you are aware of. I believe the 'powers that be' must be unaware because if this was known then surely the cemetery would not even be considered.

I do not know all the exact details so I will do my best to be as accurate as possible but if you could check out these details, that would be great. I do not know the full details because I have rang up the various councils and no one can tell me anything but I am sure that you will be able to find out the exact details of these various cemeteries. Even better is if you could make this information available to all.

- As far as I'm aware Greendale Rd falls under 3 council areas being Penrith, Liverpool and Camden. It may even fall partly in the Wollondilly council area.
- There is already one small cemetery on Greendale Rd.
- I believe that 3 more large cemeteries have been approved on Greendale Rd.
- I also think that a further one or two are in application stage.
- There is only one road out for these cemeteries, which is Greendale Rd.
- This Wallacia Cemetery is also literally at the end of Greendale Rd, in the very Centre of our currently beautiful town.

So, this would total 5 to 7 cemeteries virtually all on Greendale Rd, which I live on. If these cemeteries had a service on at similar times, just trying to get out of my driveway would be a nightmare, not to mention the traffic congestion for the Wallacia community. It's no wonder that we are getting a negative future outlook, with horrible terms being used such as 'dead city' and Wallacia Cemetery is in 'the dead centre' of town.

Have the various councils involved discussed these plans with each other? It seems that they don't. Otherwise surely this could not happen. Something is seriously wrong here.
