I object to the Dartbrook coal mine modification as referred to above. I have been told that there have been a substantial number of detailed presentations by experts to demonstrate the Proponent's application did not address many important issues; and in other cases that the details in the application were wrong, including:

- impact on the Special Economic Zones for the Equine and Viticulture industries,
