#### We are holding a public meeting and encourage you to participate!

#### Making an application to speak at our Public Meeting

The Independent Planning Commission NSW has decided to hold a public meeting to listen to the community's views on an application from the Bloomfield Group to modify the development consent for its Rix's Creek South Coal Mine under section 4.55(1A) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

Under the existing development consent (DA 49/94), Bloomfield Group is approved to extract coal from the mine until 24 June 2019. The sole purpose of this modification application (MOD 10) is to extend the 21-year approval period for coal extraction by nine months to 24 March 2020.

The extension is sought to ensure the continuity of mining operations whilst a new State Significant Development application (SSD 6300) for the continuation and expansion of the mine is assessed and determined.

The public meeting will be held at the Chameleon Room, Charbonnier, 44 Maitland Road, Singleton, NSW 2330 from 10am on Monday 20 May 2019.

If you wish to apply to speak at the public meeting, you must register your interest by completing the attached form and returning it via email to ipcn@ipcn.nsw.gov.au by 5pm on Wednesday 15 May 2019.

While the Commission will try to hear from as many people as possible on the day, it may not be possible for everyone who wishes to speak to have the opportunity to do so.
