Good afternoon Dennis,

We note that the IPCN has published on its website today an email from Howard Reed dated 23 July in relation to the air quality impacts of SSD6300.

Following an approach from DPE in the week ending 12 July, Bloomfield offered to prepare an Air Quality Report addendum that provides individual predictions of annual average PM10 and PM2.5 at five private receivers to the north west of Rix's Creek South Mine. This addendum report will address the predictions for the EIS(RRTS), Option 1 and Option 2 mine plans. The specialist consultant preparing this addendum expects to complete its analysis and report, for delivery to DPE, by 9 August 2019.

We have been advised by our specialist consultant that the Rix's Creek South Continuation Project's 'Air Quality Impact Assessment' (AQIA) model will not require any changes to address the additional information requested.

As far as we are aware, this additional addendum report will address all the outstanding information requested by DPE.

We look forward to providing this minor assessment in the earliest possible timeframe to DPE.
