## **Objection to Genesis Waste Management Facility MOD 6**

To Whom It May Concern,

We are writing to express our strong opposition to the proposed Section 75W Modification Request made by Genesis Waste Management Facility – Modification 6 (MP 06\_0139 MOD 6), which has now been referred to the Independent Planning Commission NSW for determination.

## **Our Business:**

Lite n' Easy (NSW) Pty Ltd is a provider of healthy meals to the larger NSW metro area. Many of our customers are from vulnerable sectors of society including the elderly, frail and disabled. The onset of COVID-19 now also means we supply meals to many customers who are self-isolated, guarantined and who have limited access to fresh food.

From the proposed modification, our main concern is the contamination of our facilities and the potential follow on health complications that may affect our customers, our employees and our larger business. Our other primary concern is the risk to the safety of our personnel due to the significant increase of truck and large vehicle traffic this modification will bring to an already congested traffic area.

The reason for our objection is summarized in the following categories:

## **Direct effect on Lite n' Easy NSW property:**

- Safety of our employees exiting our facility onto Honeycomb Drive with significantly increased truck traffic entering and exiting the area. There is already a large amount of truck traffic in the area.
- Waste dust and sediment settling on our building, external equipment, nature areas, employee and companies vehicles
- Potential for waste dust to infiltrate our air conditioning and extraction or exhaust systems
- Increased diesel pollution from truck movements



## **Traffic and Environmental:**

- Significant increase in large truck traffic to the local area, which already experiences substantial truck and vehicle congestion.
- There is still only one way into and out of this estate.
- The entry to the facility for all trucks and other vehicles is directly off Honeycomb Drive; right near the t-intersection of Kangaroo Drive and approximately 150m from the Grevillea St / Honeycomb Drive round-about.
- No designated off street parking for waiting trucks
- Potential damage to local roads from extra truck traffic
- Significant noise pollution to the local area from truck movement and waste unloading
- Extended hours for the non-stop delivery and unloading of waste materials
