Thank you for your email re submissions on extra material. Although I am not an expert I offer my observations. I believe the DPIE have adequately answered your concerns on the subjects presented.

- 1. 17 Level crossings is a lot in such a short distance from the mine site. Residents will have to adjust their travel time to these crossings, but night time coal train movement could present a noise problem to those who live close to the railway line.
- 2. The fact that there is emphasis on draw down of bores, the absolute drainage of Thirlmere Lakes linking to the Tahmoor mine should also be considered.
- 3. The EPA accepts the level of particulate in the air, they also accept the same in the Hunter Valley but do not recognize the concern of local GPs in the rise of asthma in children.
- 4. A V.P.A was not considered by our council.
- 5. Hume Coal jobs will not replace the tourism jobs that already exist in The Southern Highlands, and Hume Coal is only here for 20 years where as tourism jobs are sustainable. Thank you Ann Mawson.
