



PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS ON SYDNEY GRAMMAR SCHOOL – WEIGALL SPORTS COMPLEX

The Independent Planning Commission has received the Department of Planning, Industry & Environment's whole-of-government assessment report for the proposed Weigall Sports Complex at Sydney Grammar School.

Under state planning laws, the Commission is the consent authority for this state significant development application (SSD 10421) because the Department received more than 50 'unique' public objections to the Environmental Impact Statement during exhibition.

Commissioners Peter Duncan AM and Professor Richard Mackay AM have been appointed to determine this SSD application. As part of their decision-making process, they're keen to hear from interested individuals and/or groups.

Commissioners Duncan and Mackay have access to all submissions made to the Department as part of its assessment process; however, if you have any new information – or have any comments about the Department's assessment report or proposed conditions of consent – you're encouraged to make a further submission in writing to the Commission.
