**CONSENT DURATION EXTENSION FOR THE EXISTING ADVERTISING SIGNS
SOMERVILLE ROAD, ROZELLE**

Reference is made to the Department's correspondence dated 22 September 2021, regarding the abovementioned application which was referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW) for comment in accordance with clauses 17 and 18 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy No 64 - Advertising and Signage* (SEPP64).

TfNSW has reviewed the development application for the consent duration extension for the existing display of Advertising Signage on the Glebe Island Silos, with no changes to the existing illumination of the signage structure, and provides concurrence under clauses 17 and 18 of SEPP64, subject to the Department's approval and the following requirements being included in the development consent:

1. The sign design, luminance, and sign operation levels shall be in accordance with the Transport Corridor Outdoor Advertising and Signage Guidelines 2017 and relevant Australian Standards.
