Some of the information / answers provided to the commission are flawed , misleading and erroneous . ( reports on acoustics and social impact )

Paterson's busy local King st Cafes do over 250 transactions 7 days a week not just on weekends, many people travel to Paterson for the tranquil surroundings and quaint village atmosphere, this will be destroyed should the trucks return, businesses and our way of life will be ruined.

School and preschool drop off and pick up will still be affected in Bolwarra and Paterson.

I have lived in the area for over 20 years and live within walking distance of the main rd in Paterson.

We do not need the extra quarry trucks back again, No one in the village wants them.

No body trusts Daracon to follow any guidelines. They have already bought land next to another local quarry. Daracon have already profited millions from illegal operations in the past. There are numerous other more suitable

quarries that can provide any rock / ballast needs.

Development has continued without it operating since 2019.
